

Preschool Supply List

1 Large Backpack: The backpack must be big enough to easily fit a folder inside without having to fold it. Please do not send in rolling backpacks with wheels.

10 Pocket Folders: These folders will be used as daily communication between parents and teacher throughout the school year. Each month I will staple a detailed calendar of the month's activities inside a new folder. The pocket provides an excellent way for me to send home your child's work, as well as important notes and information. This is also the best way for you to transport notes from home to school. Please label each folder with your child's name with a bold, black marker on the upper right hand corner of the folder.
